



Afternoon Program Information

Wild Oak's afternoon recreational and enrichment programs are open to the public, including both homeschooled children and those from other schools. Afternoon Club and the Afternoon Academy are for K-8 students.

Afternoon Club

2:15-5:00 Monday through Friday

Afternoon Club is an outdoor-centered recreational and social program on our school campus.

\$12 per day for Wild Oak students

\$4 per day for community members attending an Afternoon Academy course

Afternoon Academy

Classes held 2:30-5:10 Monday through Friday

Courses typically run 4-6 weeks, although holidays and other closures can affect the number of days in a session.

\$90* per 5-week course **for Wild Oak students**
(\$108 for 6-week course, \$72 for 4-week)

\$100* per 5-week course **for community members**
(\$120 for 6-week course, \$80 for 4-week)

Meridian Yoga with Benjamin Bridges

2nd – 8th Grades

Do you know where your Liver is? How about your Stomach? Do you know what they do? There's a whole world inside of you! Let's explore our Inner Landscapes!

There is a living energy inside of you, moving around your body and connecting to your organs. This energy moves around through what we call Meridians. For example, the Heart Meridian travels from your pinky finger to deep in your armpits. All of your organs have their own Meridian and they use this living energy to influence our emotions, our mind and how our body works.

Sometimes energy gets stuck in our Meridians and we can experience this stuck energy as physical pain or as negative emotions like sadness or anger.

Through our Yoga practice, we discover there are hidden spots on our bodies we can press on to help ourselves feel better and stronger. It's like a secret code for health! We call these hidden spots, Acupressure Points. In our class, we will do special yoga movements to activate our hidden energies and learn about what's going on inside of us!
